

## NAME TAG HOLDER

### Materials Needed:

One fat quarter of cotton fabric

\*5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" light fusible interfacing

\*3" x 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " clear plastic

\*Provided for class

Sewing machine and supplies

Matching thread

Clips (optional, in addition to pins)

Walking foot (optional)

### Cutting instructions:

Cut one 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14" for body of holder

Cut two 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 22" for strap, sew together (using  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam) to make one long piece. Press the seam open.

### Directions:

On large piece, turn under  $\frac{3}{8}$ " twice on 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " end. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.

Fold hemmed edge up 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from bottom and press fold. Lay interfacing against the fold line and fuse to the wrong side of the fabric.

Fold down 5" from top and tuck inside lower fold, press.

Lay plastic along the lower edge of the pocket. Sew both sides and across the bottom using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam.

Fold strap in half lengthwise and press. Fold and press a second time so that raw edges are enclosed.

Turn under each raw edge  $\frac{1}{2}$ " on both ends of the strap. Trim down bulk.

Starting on one side, pin the strap to bottom and along side (clips work well on plastic), pin folded edges together, and pin along opposite side. Sew  $\frac{1}{8}$ " from folded edge to attach and finish strap. Backstitch 2-3 stitches at the beginning and ending of your sewing. Insert your name tag.
