Entry Instructions

Registration:

- The link to the *Entry Form and Story Form* can be found on our website: www.cssquilter.org.
- **Deadline for receipt of entry form is February 1, 2024 (February General Meeting).**
- Registration must include photo of finished or in-progress-entry. Computer print-out OK
- One entry form per item entered.

Required information: Name, address, email, phone, item name, dimensions (width x length inches), technique, materials used, made by, quilted by, year made, item choice (priority level of entry), quilt story and photo.

Exhibit Rules:

1. All entries must be made from fabric (no knitted, crocheted, or counted cross-stitch items)
2. Entries must be *finished* and in good condition.
3. Entries must not have been shown or displayed in a previous CSS Quilt Show.
4. All entries will be accepted until space limitations are filled. We encourage all members who have a completed quilt to submit it.
5. Please fill out one entry form for each item and select the Priority Level (1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc) of each entry. This is to ensure your favorite quilts are included if space becomes an issue.
6. If you are entering a Wearable Item, bring a blouse or turtleneck on an hanger with your item to Check-in/Intake on April 4.
7. If your entry is narrow in width (such as table runner), please designate narrowest measurement as "width" so it is hung properly.

Delivery and Pick-up

All entries must be delivered on Thursday, April 4, 2024 to 1530 London Circle, Benicia (Hastings Drive to London Circle) between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m., **OR** for those who are unable to deliver during the day due to jobs or distance, to the General Meeting deliver to the Benicia Senior Center from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Entries must be picked up after the show at the Clocktower on Sunday, April 7, 2024, between 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. (no Early Birds please) You must bring the Claim Check/Receipt with you to pick up your entries. *Please be aware of the activity in the room as we take down the show and let the vendors pack up.*

Preparing Entries for the Show:

Quilts must have a minimum 3" hanging sleeve running the width of the top back of the quilts to accommodate hanging rods. Cut the sleeve fabric a minimum of 6.5" wide to make a 3" sleeve. Instructions for making a **sewn on hanging sleeve** may be found on the "Resources" page of our website, YouTube, or in the January/February/March newsletters. The paper label (cut away from upper right corner from your entry form) must be sewn to the lower right corner of the back of each entry. **NO PINS PLEASE.**
