

"Friday's Block"

14-1/2" unfinished

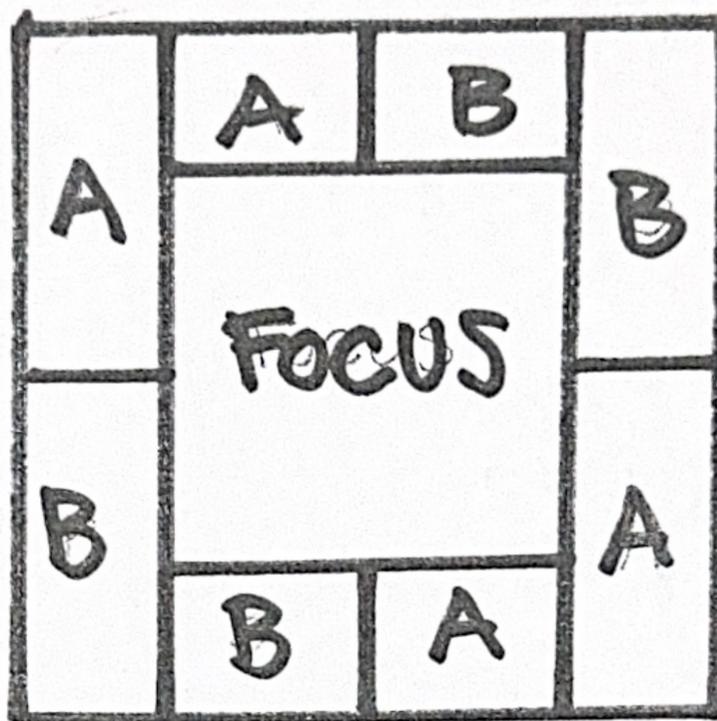
14" finished

Make 20 blocks.

Set them 4 wide x 5 high

Finished quilt is 56" x 70"

Without borders



Fabric requirements - 1-1/4 yard each of three fabrics: a focus and two contrast fabrics A and B (preferably one dark and one light)

>> Be sure you have 42" usable WOF. If not, you may need enough fabric to cut an additional strip of each contrast.

Cutting instructions

From focus fabric, cut TWENTY 8-1/2" squares

From contrast fabric A, cut TWELVE 3-1/2" WOF strips

Subcut each of EIGHT of these strips to

FIVE 7-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles and

ONE 4-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle

Subcut each of the remaining FOUR strips into

NINE 4-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles

Cut contrast fabric B the same as for A above.

Piecing instructions

1. Piece one 4-1/2" x 3-1/2" A and B contrast to each other along short sides. Press to darker fabric. Repeat for other pair of 4-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
2. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of focus square. Press to focus square.
3. Piece one 7-1/2" x 3-1/2" A and B contrast to each other along short sides. Press to darker fabric. Repeat for other pair of 7-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
4. Sew these strips to the sides of what you pieced in Step 2. Press to outside.
5. Lay blocks out four across by five high. Sew together to finish quilt top.
