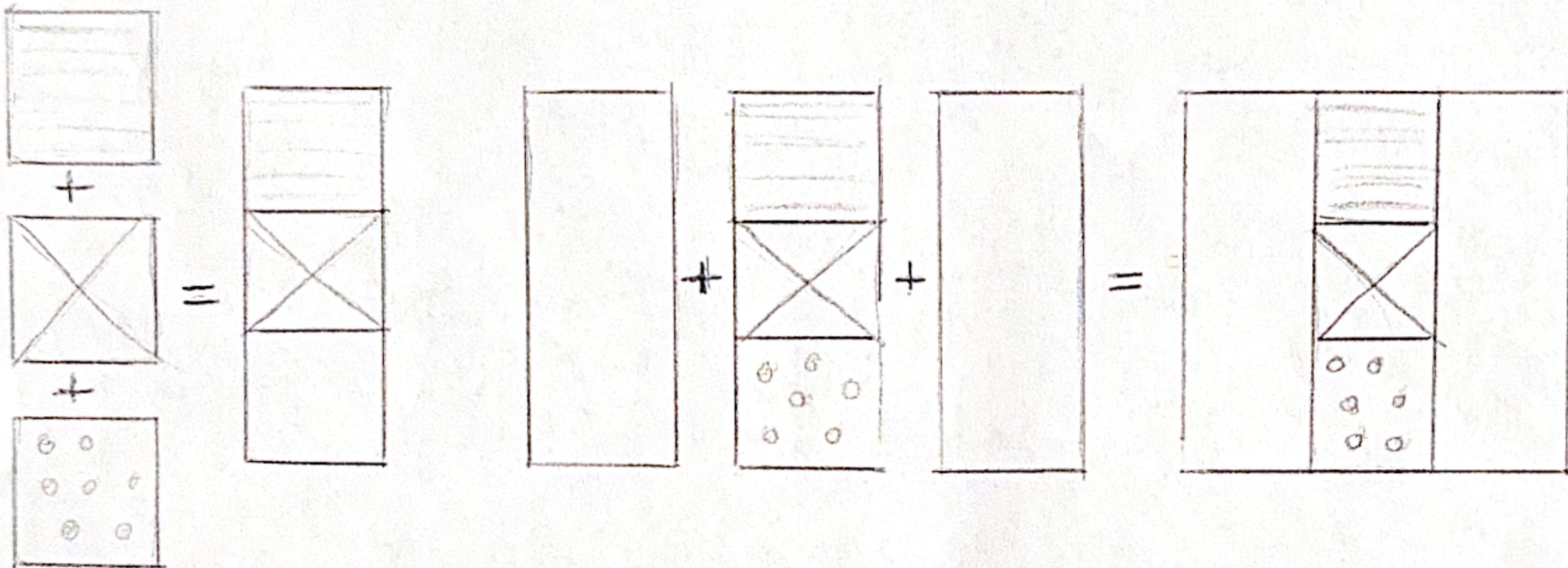


2-1/2" STRIPS - "KEYHOLE" BLOCK

Fabric needs: four of the same fabric each 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" and three 2-1/2" square blocks of three other fabrics.

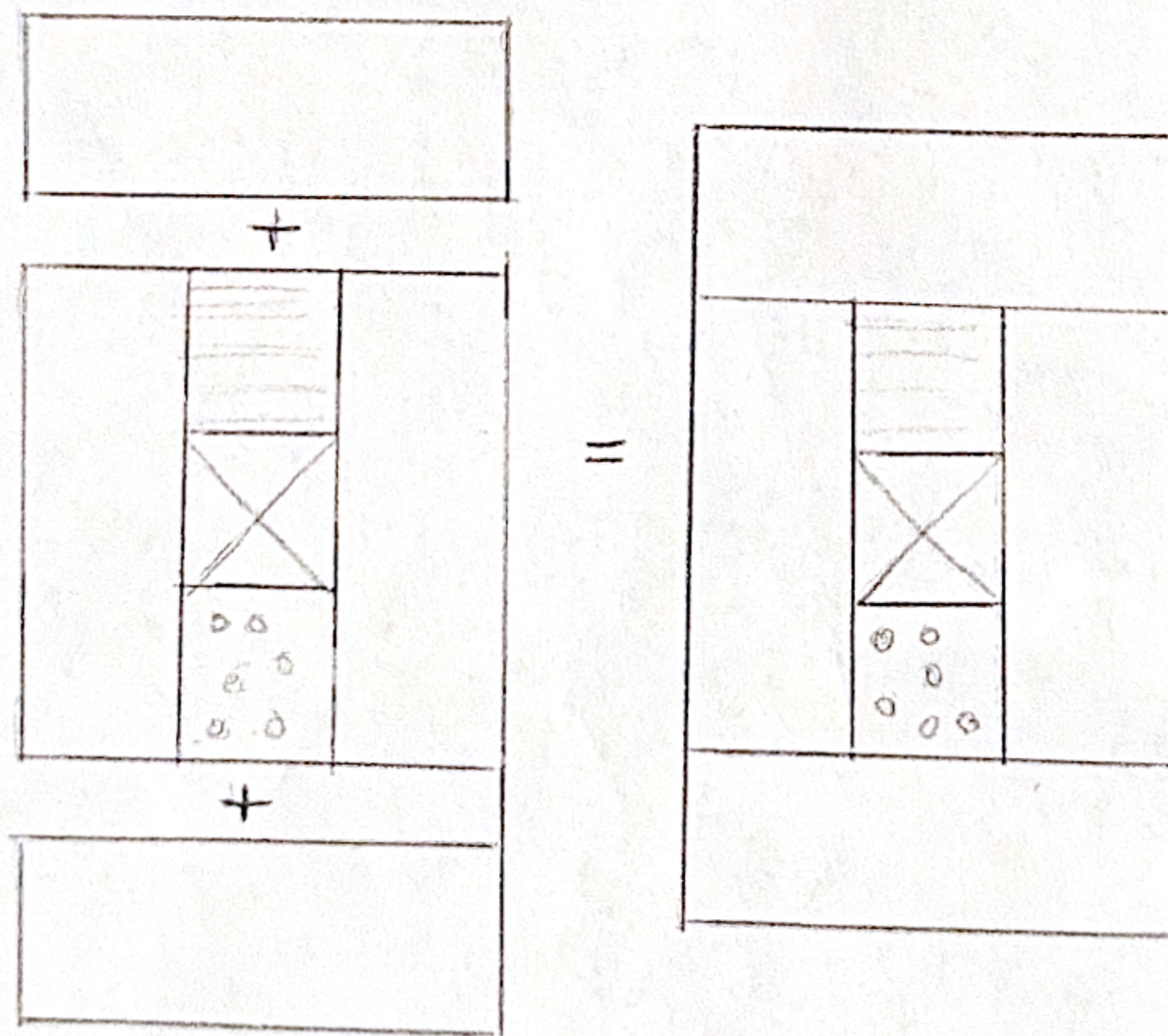
How to sew one block:

1. Sew the three 2-1/2" squares together end to end (see below left).



2. Add a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to each of the long sides of the three squares sewn above (see above center and right). You will now have a 6-1/2" square.

3. Add a 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to top and bottom of the square (see below).



Pieced blocks should measure 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished
