

## Quarter Half-Square Triangles

You will need: Four 5" charm squares and one 9-1/2" background square to make four Quarter Half-Square triangle blocks.

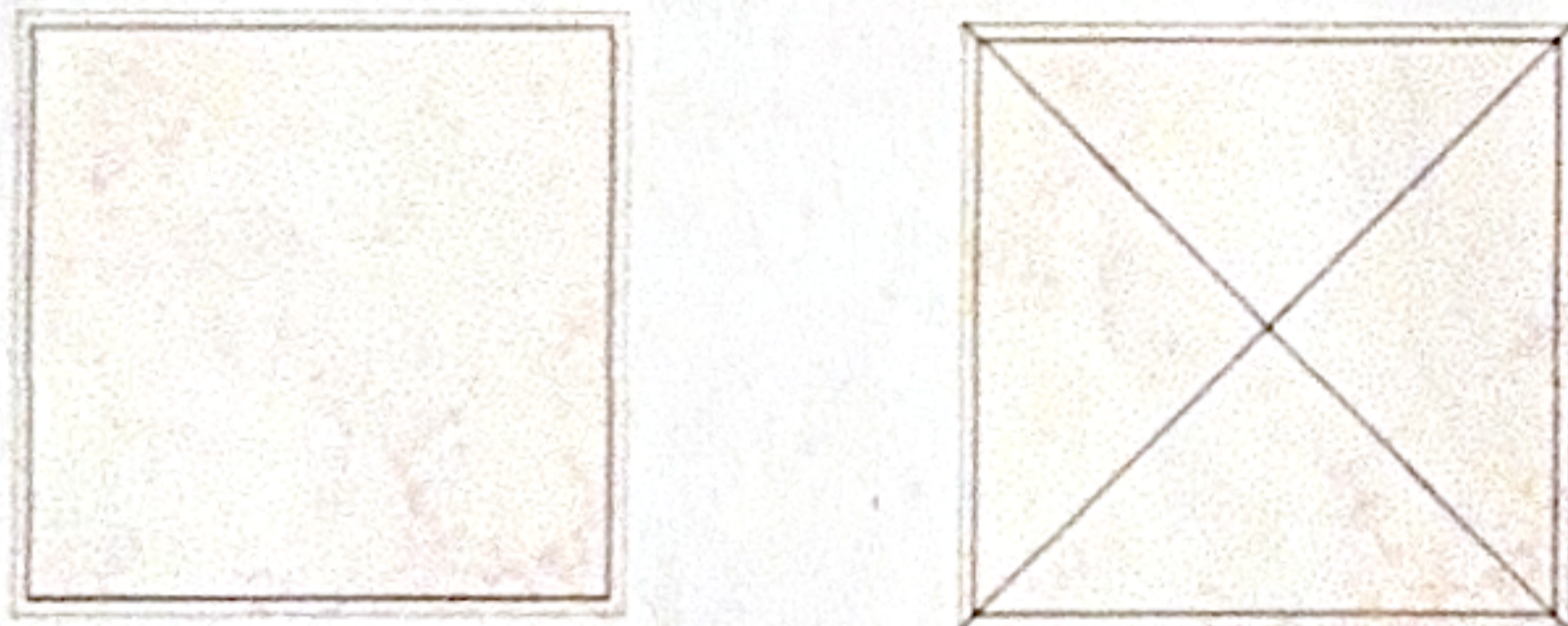
Fabric selection: Fabrics that share a seam in the four-patch block will end up next to each other in the final quarter half-square triangle block. The fabrics on opposite corners will not be in the same block so you don't need to worry about them playing well together.

The process:

1. Sew a four-patch block using four 5" charm squares. Use 1/4" seam allowance.



2. Place four-patch block right sides together with 9-1/2" background square and sew around all of the four edges (see left below).



3. Use a long ruler to cut the blocks corner to corner on both diagonals (see right above), making four quarter half-square triangles. Press to the background fabric. Block should measure 6-1/4". The outer edges of these blocks are cut on the bias, so be careful as it is very stretchy. Use spray starch if needed.
